Wales Africa project to train Community Health Workers in Mbale, Uganda

PONT's project to train Community Health Workers in Mbale has been completed!

This is what the project has achieved...

- 240 brand new Community Health Workers trained.
- 240 villages in Mbale region, formerly with no provision, now have a trained health worker!
- 120,000 people with access to life-saving healthcare in their village.
- 7 Ugandan NGOs strengthened through increased manpower.

Health care at local level is where we can make the biggest inroads into the terrible scourge of mothers, babies and children dying of preventable causes.

Our 240 new Community Health Workers are agents for change in their villages and are already sending reports of how they are improving hygiene and sanitation and caring for pregnant mothers and sick children.

We are extremely grateful to the Welsh Government for making this grant available to PONT and our Ugandan partners. We are confident that this investment is an investment for years to come, and that it will lead to the saving of many lives.
